COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP:

The San Onofre Parks Foundation will award up to four (4) \$1,000 scholarships for graduating San Clemente High School seniors attending an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university in the fall of 2017. *Application deadline is Saturday, April 15, 2017.* The winner(s) will be honored during the Senior Awards Ceremony at SCHS on May 18, 2017.

PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIPS:

The San Onofre Parks Foundation offers financial aid to college-bound students who demonstrate interest in environmental studies and issues relevant to the preservation and protection of our State Parks, their natural and cultural resources and the mission of the San Onofre Parks Foundation.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. San Clemente High School senior in good standing with a minimum academic GPA (weighted) of 3.5
2. Planned study emphasis in the area of Environmental Studies
3. Enrollment in an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university for fall 2017
4. Demonstrated interest in environmental concerns through volunteer service
5. Complete and submit all required application materials and signatures by the deadline: April 15, 2017
Include transcript, letter(s), typed essay, printed and SIGNED application form

APPLICATION SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

1. Completed application with required signatures
2. Current official academic transcript with 7th semester (fall) grades
3. One confidential letter of recommendation from a teacher, employer, or community member unrelated to applicant.
(Limited to one typed page)
4. Essay (400-600 words, typed)
