## CONSTRUCTION HIGHLIGHTS



**Nighttime Freeway Lane Closures:** Night work is scheduled to take place from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. tonight, June 2, and Monday, June 3, on the northbound and southbound I-5 freeway bridges over the Stonehill Drive/Camino Capistrano on-ramp, Camino Las Ramblas and Pacific Coast Highway. Crews will be saw-cutting pavement as part of joint seal work to allow for the expansion and contraction of the bridges.

Please be advised, this work may be loud and disruptive. The outside lanes in both directions on I-5 may be closed intermittently to allow crews to safely perform this work.

**Median Demo Work:** The two innermost lanes on the northbound and southbound I-5 freeway between Avenida Palizada and El Camino Real are scheduled to close from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday, June 5, through Friday, June 9, to allow crews to place k-rail in preparation of demo work.

Crews are expected to demo the existing median concrete barrier to place new overhead signs for the carpool lanes. Demo is scheduled to begin by the end of next week.

**Intermittent Pico Ramp Closures:** The Avenida Pico northbound and southbound I-5 on- and off-ramps will be closed intermittently at night from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for the next several weeks. Motorists should use Avenida Vista Hermosa and Calle Frontera as detours.

**Avenida Pico Closures:** Crews are scheduled to remove falsework from the Avenida Pico bridge. The work will require full nighttime closures of Avenida Pico underneath the freeway bridge from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., beginning Monday, June 12 and lasting up to two weeks. The northbound I-5 on- and off-ramp also will be closed. Motorists should use Avenida Vista Hermosa and Calle Frontera as detours.
